The Board of Trustees of Shawnee County Fire District #1 met in regular session at Silver Lake City Hall on Wednesday, January 13, 2010, with the following board members present: Chairman Mike Killion, Gene Wichman, Leonard Wonnell, Walt Stolle, and Tom Noble. Also present were Chief Joe Hawkins, Assistant Chief Wilson, and Captain Brummer.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Board reviewed the minutes of the meeting held December 17, 2009. It was moved by Wonnell and seconded by Noble to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried 5-0.

Board reviewed the bills paid during the month of December 2009, totaling \$103,982.79. It was moved by Noble, and seconded by Wichman to approve the bills paid. Motion carried 5-0.

Chief Hawkins reported the number of calls in 2009 was 267. The total for 2008 was 228.

Old Business:

SCBA: New equipment will be delivered January 14th, with training next week.

New AEDs have been received, and have been installed in the ambulance and one of the engines.

New Business:

Chief reported on the recent blizzard and thanked the townships and the city for their help in getting the roads open, with a special thanks to Dave Taylor from Menoken Township for his help in getting a patient removed from a residence and transported out of the area.

Chief reported on previous termite damage found while the office in the Silver Lake station was being remodeled.

Chief reported our mechanic is doing equipment repair at the Grove station. Chief is looking to purchase a fireproof storage cabinet for chemical storage.

Chief mentioned a crack that has appeared in the floor of the Grove station.

Executive Session:

Noble made a motion to enter executive session for a period of 15 minutes to discuss personnel. Seconded by Wonnell, and carried 5-0.

Executive session began at 7:02 p.m.

Noble made a motion at 7:17 p.m. to continue the executive session an additional 10 minutes. Seconded by Wonnell, and carried 5-0.
