The Board of Trustees of Shawnee County Fire District #1 met in regular session at Silver Lake City Hall on Wednesday, March 10, 2010, with the following board members present: Chairman Mike Killion, Gene Wichman, Leonard Wonnell, Walt Stolle, and Tom Noble. Also present was Captain Graig Brummer to represent Chief Hawkins who was attending SCAFFA School.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Board reviewed the minutes of the meeting held February 10, 2010. It was moved by Wichman and seconded by Wonnell to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried 5-0.

Board reviewed the bills paid during the month of February totaling \$19,620.64. It was moved by Wichman and seconded by Noble to approve the bills paid, with the stipulation that bills from Oreilly Auto Parts and Mike Fangman be explained next meeting. Motion carried 5-0.

Capt. Brummer reported the number of 2010 calls to date as 45. As of this date in 2009, 68 calls had been reported.

## Old Business:

Menoken Township building project survey: Capt. Brummer presented the board with a revised survey and cover letter to be mailed to all residents of the district. Kinko's submitted a bid for printing and mailing of \$2600.00 for 2000 pieces.

Noble made a motion to have the Chief and building committee send out the survey as it was written in the most economical fashion. Wonnell seconded the motion and it carried 5-0.

## New Business:

Capt. Brummer presented a proposal from Chief Hawkins to purchase a slide in self-contained pump, motor, hose reel, tank, and nozzle for the Polaris Ranger. The price quote from Unruh Fire in Sedgwick, KS is \$4,595.00.

Killion made a motion to purchase the unit. Noble seconded the motion, and it carried 5-0.
