The Board of Trustees of Shawnee County Fire District #1 met in regular session at Silver Lake City Hall on Wednesday, January 12, 2011, with the following board members present: Chairman Mike Killion, Gene Wichman, Leonard Wonnell, and Tom Noble. Walt Stolle was absent

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Board reviewed the minutes of the meeting held December 8, 2010. It was moved by Wichman, and seconded by Noble to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried 4-0.

Board reviewed the bills paid during the month of December, totaling \$24,630.29. It was moved by Wichman, and seconded by Wonnell to approve the bills paid. Motion carried 4-0.

Chief Hawkins reported the total number of calls in 2010 was 215. There were 267 calls in 2009.

Old Business:

Wonnell reported the floor repair patch has been poured in the Grove station.

Chief Hawkins reported Emergency Management might be able to fund a replacement siren for the south end of Silver Lake if a grant is not received.

Chief Hawkins reported the SCBA radio interfaces should be ordered soon through Shawnee County Emergency Communications, and paid for by Nextel.

New Business:

Chief Wilson advised that one of our members has expressed an interest in taking a paramedic class. It was discussed whether the board would be interested in paying part of the cost. Wilson was asked to draft a policy that addresses partial payment for the class based on the length of time a member continues with the department.

Adjournment:

Noble made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Wonnell, and carried 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 6:28.
