The Board of Trustees of Shawnee County Fire District #1 met in regular session at Silver Lake City Hall on Wednesday, June 8, 2011, with the following board members present: Chairman Mike Killion, Gene Wichman, Leonard Wonnell, and Tom Noble. Walt Stolle was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Board reviewed the minutes of the meeting held May 11, 2011. It was moved by Wichman, and seconded by Noble, to approve the minutes as corrected. Motion carried 4-0.

Board reviewed the bills paid during the month of May totaling \$15,899.43. It was moved by Wonnell, and seconded by Noble, to approve the bills paid. Motion carried 4-0.

Chief Hawkins reported the number of 2011 calls to date as 138. As of this date in 2010, 103 calls had been reported.

Old Business:

Menoken building project: Chief Hawkins reported he met with a KDOT engineer who said he had no problems with the proposed location. Future highway plans should not be a concern.

Barry Beagle with Shawnee County said he does not know of anything to restrict building in that location.

KSNT will be submitting a letter concerning liability for tower collapse. We will meet with our attorney to discuss the letter when presented.

Gear Storage: Chief reported the storage units are being installed at this time. New fluorescent lighting is also being installed in the bays in Silver Lake.

New Business: Budget will be discussed at the July meeting.

Noble made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Wonnell, and carried 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 6:25.
