The Board of Trustees of Shawnee County Fire District #1 met in regular session at Silver Lake City Hall on Wednesday, July 13, 2011, with the following board members present: Chairman Mike Killion, Gene Wichman, Leonard Wonnell, Walt Stolle, and Tom Noble.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Board reviewed the minutes of the meeting held June 8, 2011. It was moved by Wonnell, and seconded by Wichman, to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried 5-0.

Board reviewed the bills paid during the month of June totaling \$47,421.87. It was moved by Wichman, and seconded by Noble, to approve the bills paid. Motion carried 5-0.

Chief Hawkins reported the number of 2011 calls to date as 157. As of this date in 2010, 122 calls had been reported.

## Old Business:

Menoken building project: Chief Hawkins reported he spoke with KSNT general manager, who is still waiting to hear from their legal department.

Silver Lake station: Chief reported the new lockers have been installed, and he has heard many favorable comments about them. The lighting upgrade is almost complete.

## New Business:

Budget: Killion reported he and Chief Hawkins met with County Clerk's office about the 2012 budget. The 2011 mill levy is 7.498. A 2012 levy of 7.488 will produce approximately \$5,000 less revenue. Wichman made a motion to adopt a budget for 2012 that has a mill levy of 7.488. Noble seconded the motion which carried 5-0.

Bunker Gear: Chief reported NFPA standards call for replacement of protective clothing be done after 7 years. Much of ours is older than that. Chief will obtain bids and suggestions for a replacement schedule.

Complaint: Chief received a complaint about a fireworks display July 9<sup>th</sup>. The display required a permit that had been issued by the Chief. Chief advised the permittee followed all restrictions and requirements.

Adjournment: With no further items to be discussed, the meeting was adjourned at 6:51.
